In January I swung by San Felipe and the Stephen F. Austin State Park and down to Rosenberg, Texas to the greatly improved Rosenberg RR Museum. I took two extra days to go to our great meet in McKinney, Texas. I stopped off in Waco to visit the Dr. Pepper Museum and Roadside America in Hillsboro. I then spent a day and half at the Fort Worth Stockyards that have been greatly improved during Covid. The next day was spent at the Frisco Museum of the American Railroad and revisited Bob and Dinah Carter's home in Plano to see their 20x20 detailed layout.

The year before I stopped off at Granbury to see **David Kross's** train layout/ museum and then Cleburne to see the *Gone With the Wind Museum, the Cleburne Railroad Museum* and the 1919 *ATSF #3417* – (1 of 50) 3400 Class Pacific type (4-6-2) by Baldwin Locomotive Works.

This year I returned to the October TCA Eastern Division's York Meet. **Mark Boyd–TCA Quarterly Editor** and I drove over to the Hershey *Antique Automobile Club Association Museum* (AACA) again as they have rotating exhibits. The next day we went to the **Gettysburg**, **PA Battlefield** (about the 8-10th time for me). The next day we went to Strasburg, home of the *Choo-Choo Barn* and met with the new owner. Then on to OUR TCA *National Toy Train Museum* around the corner.


